Friends of Summerhill positions to be filled

Chair

The Chair is responsible for the overall organisation and running of FOS;

- Set agendas and lead meetings.
- Set what events will run each year.
- Delegate and co-ordinate jobs to other volunteers.
- Liaise with school to decide where funds will be spent.
- Write a (short) annual report giving an overview of what FOS have achieved.

Vice-Chair

The Vice-Chair supports the Chair in all aspects of running FOS;

- Contributes to agendas, setting events and annual report.
- Steps into chair meetings when needed.
- Helps to delegate and co-ordinate jobs needed to run events.

Treasurer

The Treasurer is responsible for the financial side of running FOS;

- Keeps records of FOS accounts.
- Details how much events take, expenses and profit.
- Organises floats for events.
- Manages FOS bank account.
- Writes a (short) annual report giving an overview of FOS accounts for the year.
- You do not need to attend events or all meetings to do this role.

Communications

The communications role involves advertising FOS events;

- Write termly newsletters highlighting FOS events and activities.
- Write letters and flyers advertising specific events.
- Liaise with school to make sure FOS communications are sent out in good time.

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
