Purpose

At Summerhill Infant School our policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school or after school events is based on the belief that our school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Creates a sense of community and belonging within our school
- Is practical, smart and designed with practicality and health and safety in mind
- Identifies the children with the school
- Ensures that children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- Is accessible, affordable and is good value for money

Winter – Girls and Boys

Fleece – Royal blue with Summerhill Infant School logo

Sweatshirt/Cardigan - Royal blue with Summerhill Infant School logo

Polo Shirt/Shirt/Blouse - White

Trousers/Skirt/Pinafore - Dark grey

Socks - White/grey

Tights - Royal blue/white/grey

Sensible, safe and tidy black footwear (no trainers)



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Summer - Boys and Girls

Short or long trousers – Dark grey

Short or long-sleeved shirt - White

Polo shirt

Summer dress – Striped or checked in blue/white

Socks – White or grey

Sensible, safe and tidy black footwear (no trainers)

Physical Education

Sensible shorts

White T shirt

Navy tracksuit bottoms

Plimsolls (daps)

Shoe bag, or similar, in which to keep the PE kit. Royal blue drawstring logo bags available from the school

Wellingtons for Forest School sessions

Outdoor PE sessions will require socks and trainers or plimsolls.

During indoor PE sessions children are bare foot in order to ensure a firm grip.

Earrings should be removed on PE days.

Book Bags

Book Bags keep books in good condition so children do not need to bring another bag with them.

Bags take up a great deal of space on cloakroom pegs and often end up on the floor. If children are requested to bring something into school to show his/her class then a reusable bag, which can be neatly folded away, will be sufficient.

Books Bags (royal blue) with the school logo are given free to each child when they start school.

Jewellery and Make - Up

Children must not wear jewellery, including hooped earrings and brooches to school. Jewellery may get lost and we cannot accept responsibility. More importantly, it can be a hazard when children play games.

Make-up including nail polish is not acceptable in school

All uniform can be purchased from high-street shops, online or in major supermarkets, except for items with the Summerhill Infant School logo. These can be purchased from Summerhill Infant School directly.

The only items that we require to have the school logo are the fleece/sweatshirt/cardigan and Book Bag.



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Labelling

One drawback of school uniform is that all clothes look the same and there can be a build up of lost property at the end of each term.

Please ensure that all items of clothing, including shoes are clearly labelled with your child's <u>full name</u>. Labelling may need to be renewed at regular intervals as names do tend to wear off in the wash.

Outgrown and Old Uniform

We encourage Parents/Carers to donate to the school old and outgrown logo uniform which is in good condition to reduce landfill and help protect the environment.

Second hand logo uniform is also available to purchase from the school office.
