Sculpture	A sculpture is a 2D or 3D piece of art that has been carved, chiselled or modelled into something like a statue.
Form	The visible shape or configuration of something, the way something appears or exists.
Join	To link and connect materials.
Materials	Sculptures can be made out of different materials such as wire, buttons, pencils etc.
Carving	Carving is a way of making a sculpture, you can use tools to carve marks or cut the material.
Modelling	Modelling is how we use our hands to create something using abstract and mathematical thinking.

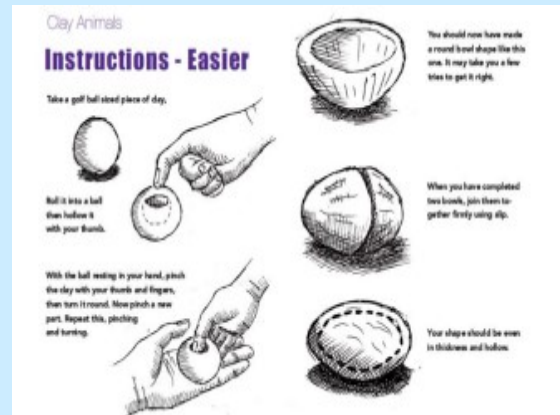

What is clay?

Clay is a fine-grained mineral made when rocks break down. Wet clay is soft and can be shaped to make pottery, bricks and other things. When it is shaped and then fired in a kiln to make it hard, it becomes pottery

How can I create pattern and texture?

It is easy to create different textures and patterns by carving into blocks of Clay that have had some time to dry a little. Using Clay Tools, it is possible to carve simple designs that are informed by shapes or patterns observed in nature, or from other cultures; such as the Ancient Greeks, or geometric African patterns

Model

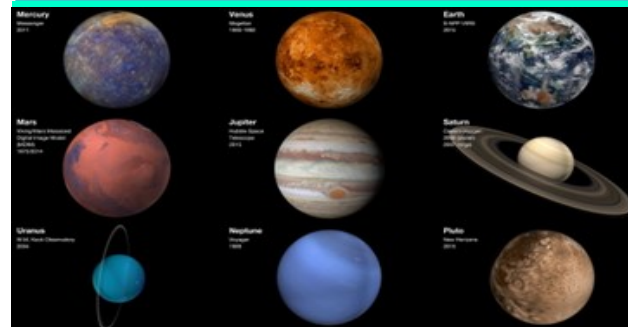
A small exact copy of something
