Moving a robot

Robots follow clear, fixed commands in a predictable way. A sequence of commands form an algorithm.

We will be following and writing our own algorithms to follow different routes with the 'beebots'. This will practise our understanding of forwards, backwards, turn left, turn right.



Two of the buttons

make the floor robot move forwards and backwards. Two of the buttons make the robot turn left or right but remain in the same place.

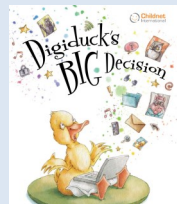

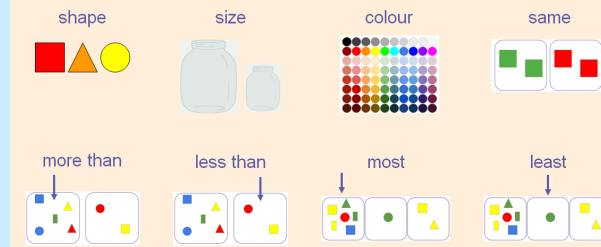

Grouping Data

Objects can be grouped and classified based on their properties.

Vocabulary for describing



Objects or groups of objects can be described by their label. Their label helps them to be spoken about and found easily.

Grouping objects can make them more easily looked at and compared.

Comparing objects is when you look at what is similar and what is different.

Word processors are applications that allow us to create text on computers.

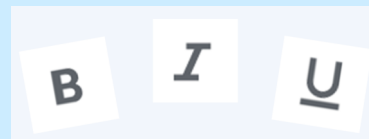
Keyboards allow us to press keys to add text.

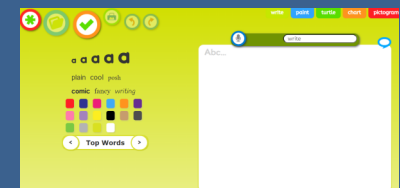

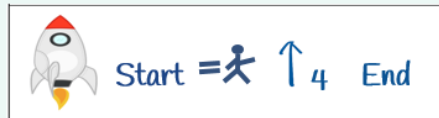
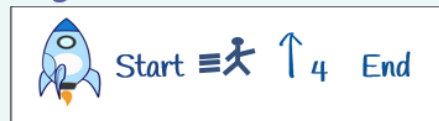
Programming animations
