PE provides opportunities for pupils to be creative, competitive and to face up to different challenges as individuals, in groups and teams.

PE promotes positive attitudes towards active and healthy lifestyles.

The PE Curriculum

We deliver the P.E. curriculum through a scheme of work called Real P.E. We supplement this with enriching activities such as dance and using large P.E. apparatus.

Team games
Fencing
Target games (including archery)
Athletics
Gymnastics
