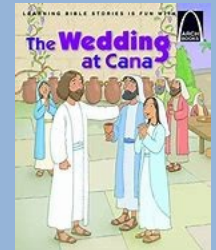
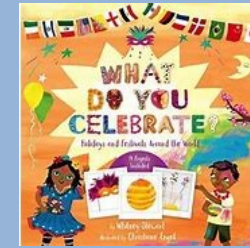
word	definition

Community

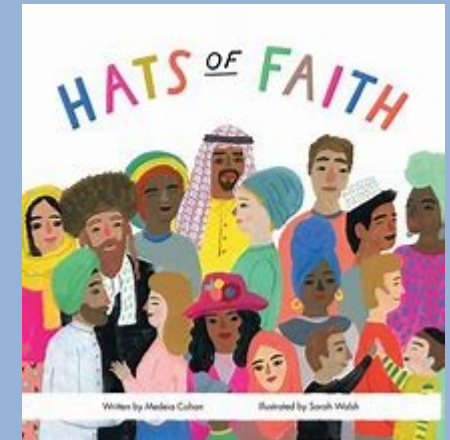
A group of people living in a particular area.

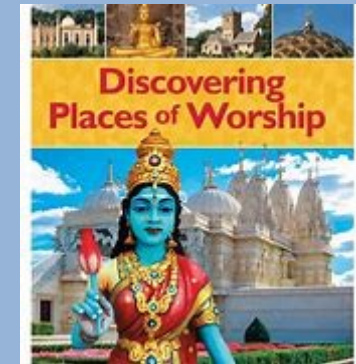
