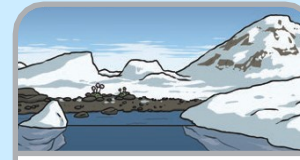
Subject Specific Vocabulary

word	definition
endangered	At risk of being extinct.
habitat	A habitat is the natural place something lives. A habitat provides living things with everything they need to survive such as food, shelter and water.
rainforest	A large group of trees in a hot wet place.
artic	A very cold place at the north pole. Ant-artic is the south pole.
ocean	A large body of salt water.
desert	A very dry place. It can be hot or cold.
mountain	Land which has steep slopes up & down.
survive	This means to stay alive.
depend	Many living things in a habitat depend on each other. This means they need each other for different things.

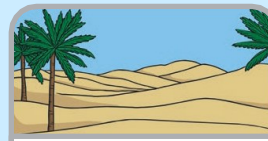

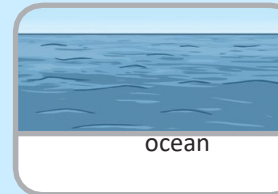

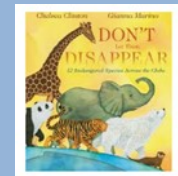
