
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Dear Parents/Carers,

100 day celebrations – your help please!

In their classes, the children count the number of days they have been in school this academic year on a place value chart (pictured below). They add a straw for every school day and discuss the number of hundreds, tens and ones being represented, as a tool to support their knowledge and understanding of place value.



On the 21st February, there will have been 100 school days this academic year. We would like to use this an opportunity to celebrate and promote maths across the school.

We would love for the day to begin with an assembly in which parents and carers share with the children how they use maths in their everyday lives.
