

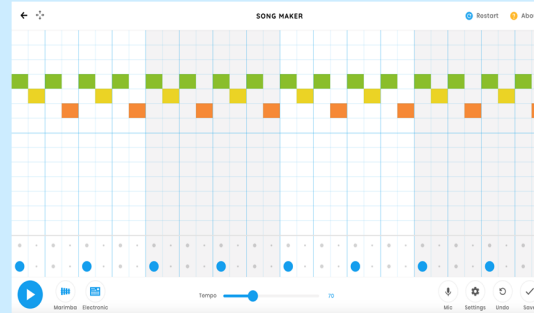

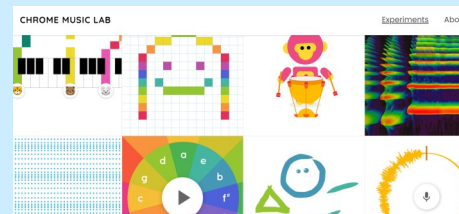
Digital Music

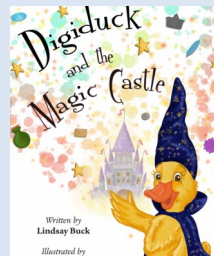
