We can find out about our local environment by carrying out fieldwork.

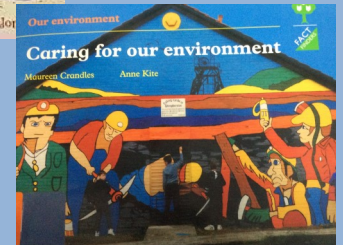
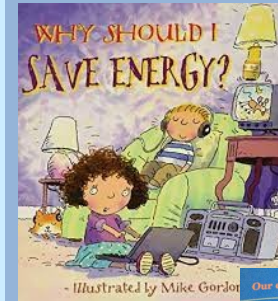


We can see what is in the area around us and how we would like to improve it.

We can look at school and decide what we like about a place and what we would improve.

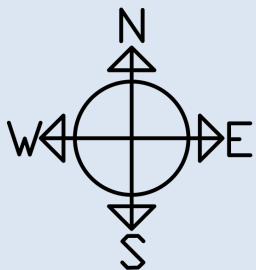
Be careful when you are carrying out fieldwork. Always look where you are going and stay with a grown up.
