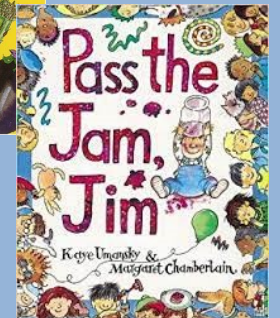
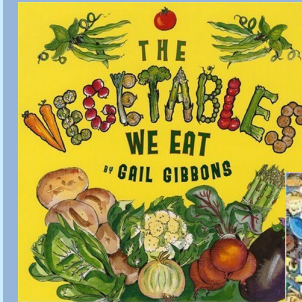
The food we eat can travel from nearby and far away.

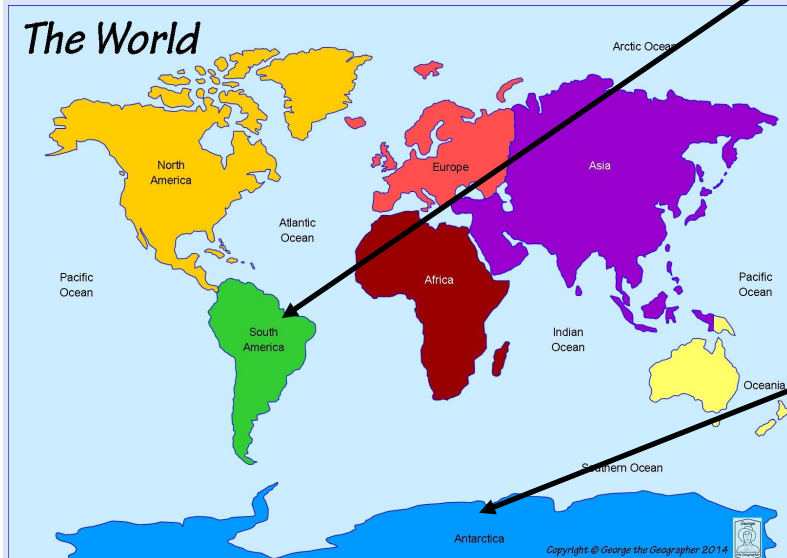
There is lots of water in the rainforest. There can be about 4 meters of rain a year in the Amazon.
