You may have heard about the Government's School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme. Under the Scheme, each child aged 4 - 6 in LA maintained schools will be entitled to receive a free piece of fruit or vegetable each school day. Scientists agree that everybody, including children, can reduce their risk of heart disease and cancer by eating at least five portions of fruit and vegetables every day. On average, children in the UK eat only two portions a day.
