SEND Practice Leadership Team

Bristol City Council (BCC) is dedicated to improving support for children with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND). They are doing this in two ways: Firstly, they are looking at the level of need in the local area in order to allocate places in specialist provision more appropriately.

Secondly, BCC are establishing a new SEND Practice Leadership Team to assist families in transitioning their children from alternative provisions back to local mainstream or specialist schools where appropriate. To read more click here.



PINS Project Update

The Partnerships for inclusion of Neurodiversity in schools (PINS) project is a national initiative led by the Department for Education,
Department for Health and Social Care and NHS England. Bristol Parent Carers have been working with the ICB and Parent Carer forums in North Somerset and South Glos to deliver this project across the area, our aim is to better support education accessibility for neurodivergent pupils. The project has now launched in 20 participating schools across Bristol with participating schools receiving £5000 funding to support inclusive strategies.
