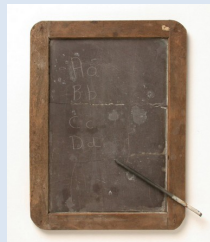
## Subject Specific Vocabulary

## Sticky Knowledge



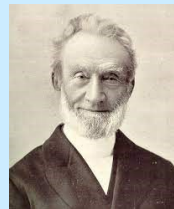
Queen Victoria reigned for 63 years and seven months. It was a time of great industrial change in the United Kingdom. The Victorian era is named after her.



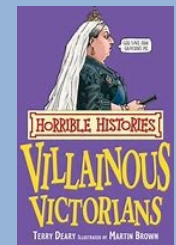
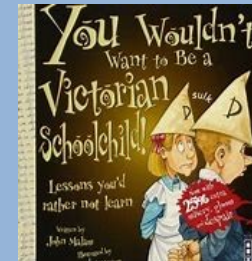
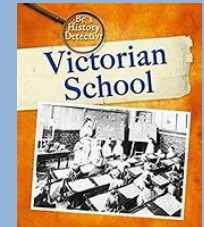
Isambard Kingdom Brunel was a famous engineer who designed many things including the Clifton Suspension Bridge, the Great Western Railway and the SS Great Britain.
