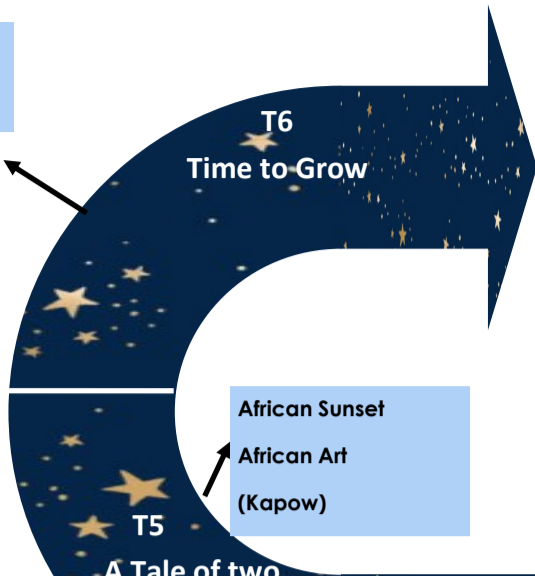


## Art

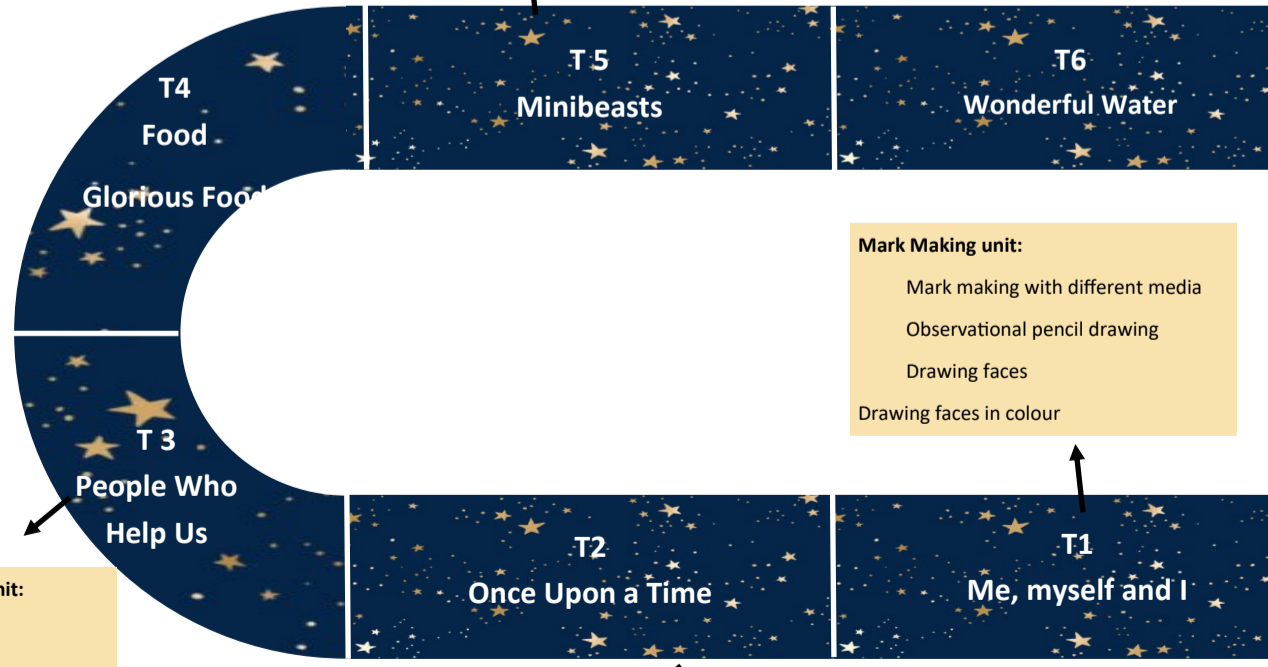
