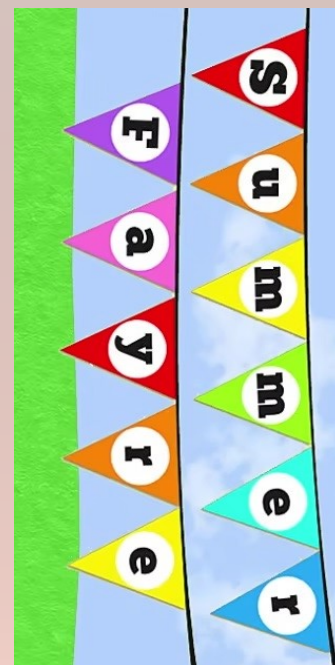
Friends of Summerhill Infants (FOSI)
